How NI Uses C2P:

- Daily email alerts on topics of interest
- Assessments to see whether a new piece of legislation is relevant
- Tasks – assigning ownership and action items
- Entering comments
- Alert sharing with other members of the organization

By monitoring the daily update alerts that C2P provides, we not only immediately understand new and proposed regulatory changes but also can actively participate in industry organizations. We can monitor the alerts and react in time, across our whole business, to meet new requirements. Building on this, the C2P management tools allow us to evaluate legislation just once and document it. Anytime we have questions, C2P serves as our single source for these assessments. It may not be obvious, but companies spend a significant amount of time assessing the same law, which wastes time and resources.
